

**PROPOSAL FOR ADMISSION TO THE EAST ASIAN STUDIES LATIN HONORS PROGRAM**

Application to the program must be made by March 31 of the junior year. All honors proposals will be reviewed by EAS. Students will be notified of their acceptance no later than April 15.

Latin Honors are determined on the basis of a student's performance throughout eight semesters in the college. To be eligible for such honors, the student must have maintained a 3.65 grade point average through the sixth semester and must be accepted for candidacy by the East Asian Studies program. Latin Honors candidates must enroll in L03 486 and/or 487 Independent Work for Senior Honors, satisfactorily complete a senior honors thesis by March 1 of senior year, and pass the thesis oral defense.
